Sub: CBCS - PG Programmes I year (II Semester) – April 2024 Examinations – Guidelines – Reg.

I request you to follow the guidelines given below for the ensuing April 2024 examinations of Even Semester.

- Kindly prepare the timetable for PG programmes I year II semester examinations including Odd semester arrear papers and send a copy to CBCS office on or before 19.04.2024.
- 2. The minimum attendance for each semester is fixed as 75%. If a candidate fails to make 75% of attendance, but makes upto 65%, the student will have to produce medical certificate. For less than 65% and upto 60%, the student will have to produce medical certificate and pay a penalty of Rs.500 for each paper. For less than 60% attendance, the student has to repeat the semester. The list of students and attendance details for each program need to be prepared and send the same to the CBCS office on or before 19-04-2024.
- Internal marks should be published and displayed on the School / Department notice board and a copy should also be sent to CBCS Office on or before <u>22.04.2024</u>.
- 4. Kindly send the Elective and NME papers offered in your School / Department and NME opted by your I year (II semester) students to CBCS section on or before 08.03.2024. After the receipt of the above, the Nominal roll with examination fee for each student prepared by the CBCS section to save time of the examination application process.

5. The office of the Schools/ Departments/ Centres should get the signature of the students

after the verification of the Nominal roll and the same may be sent alongwith the fees

paid and the necessary enclosures to CBCS section on or before 08.04.2024. If any

correction/alteration in the Nominal roll please inform the CBCS section immediately and

get it corrected.

6. Examination for all NME (Non-Major Elective) Courses need to be conducted on 03.05.2024 in

the forenoon session, the Core and Elective Courses may be conducted from 06.05.2024

onwards.

7. Question bank may be prepared and made available to the students as was done in the earlier

semesters.

8. Please note that the provisional results, as per CBCS regulations, should be published on or

before 21.05.2024 for PG Programmes and a copy of the provisional results along with the

Minutes of School / Dept. Council should be sent to CBCS office after publication and the

same has to be displayed on the School / Department notice board immediately.

9. Final results should be sent along with the Minutes of School / Dept. Council meeting and

the Foil cards within 10 days after the publication of provisional results (if there is no

revaluation).

10. The Chairperson of the School / Head of the Department are requested to verify and sign in the

individual mark statements while issuing to the students.
