Report of the NAAC Sponsored Two Day State Level Workshop on NAAC Accreditation of Colleges: Revised Accreditation Framework

A two day State Level Workshop on ‘NAAC Accreditation of Colleges: Revised Accreditation Framework’ was organized by Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Madurai Kamaraj University with the financial support from NAAC, Bangalore during 29th to 30th July 2019. This workshop is meant to disseminate knowledge on NAAC accreditation, which helps the higher learning institutes to know its strengths, opportunities, and challenges through an informed review process. Invitations were sent to 98 colleges spread over four districts which are affiliated to Madurai Kamaraj University. There were 152 participants (88 Men and 64 Women) from 80 colleges and 74 faculty members from Madurai Kamaraj University. Majority of the participants were faculty members associated with IQAC/NIRF ranking from the respective institutions. The workshop comprised of three lecture sessions and hands on trainings. Prof. M. Krishnan, Vice Chancellor presided over and inaugurated the function wherein he elaborated about the Overview of NAAC assessment and its significance. In the first technical session, Dr. Sujata Shanbhag, Deputy Adviser, NAAC, Bangalore delivered a lecture on ‘Overview of NAAC’s Revised Accreditation Framework’ and Dr. Vinita Sahu, Assistant Adviser, NAAC, Bangalore spoke on ‘Institutional preparedness before, during and after submission of SSR’. In the interactive session, the resource persons clarified the doubts related to Revised Accreditation Framework raised by the participants. In the 2nd day, online hands on trainings were given to the participants about the submission of IQA and SSR in the web portal of NAAC by the authorities of NAAC, Dr. Sujata Shanbhag and Dr. Vinita Sahu. Later, Dr. S. Theenathayalan, Member Syndicate, Madurai Kamaraj University delivered a lecture on ‘Understanding NAAC’. Prof. R. Sudha, The Registrar, Madurai Kamaraj University delivered valedictory address. Prof. K. Balakrishnan, Director, IQAC, MKU proposed vote of thanks. Prof. S. Murugesan, NIRF Co-ordinator, MKU, Prof. P. Rajkumar, Convener and Dr. B. Ashokkumar, Organizing Secretary with the team of IQAC members made all the arrangements for the successful completion of this great workshop.

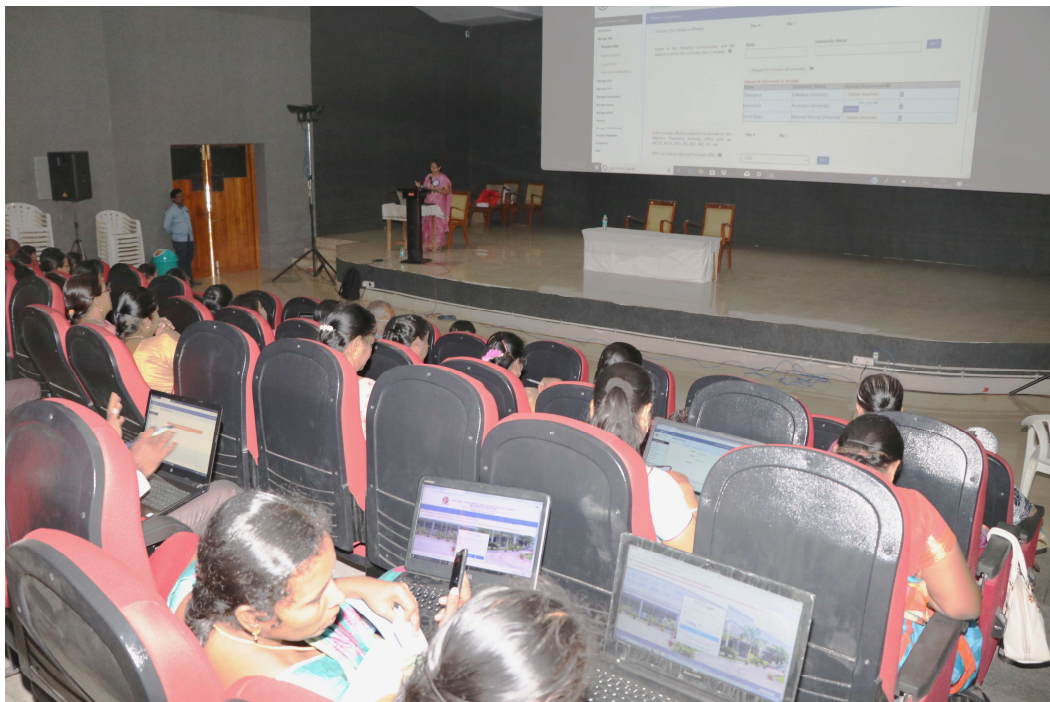





'Improve green initiatives for good NAAC accreditation'

Madurai: Vice-chancellor (VC) of the Madurai Kamaraj University (MKU) M Krishnan has exhorted colleges to come up with innovative environmental initiatives in order to achieve good accreditation by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). He said this while delivering an address at a two-day state level workshop on 'NAAC Accreditation of Colleges: Revised Accreditation and Framework' organized on Monday and Tuesday.

Speaking at the event, Krishnan said that environmental consciousness was an important aspect (under criterion VII under the Quality Indicator Framework (QIF) of NAAC accreditation and colleges should not overlook it. "Many colleges might have good faculty, good students and so on. But lack of emphasis to environmental consciousness, especially if they don't come up with any innovative initiative, could be a disadvantage to them with regards to NAAC accreditation," he said.

Many colleges have rain-water harvesting systems and impose plastic ban in campuses, but they do not take enough innovative steps when it comes to environment, Krishnan added. "The Manonmaniam Sundaranar University (MSU) received very good response when it made mandatory for faculty and students to use only bicycles within the campus. Initiatives like this could be undertaken in other colleges too," he said.
