




CODE OF CONDUCT AND SCALE OF PUNISHMENT FOR STUDENTS IN EXAMINATION PROCESS

(Syndicate approval dated 19-05-2006)

S.No.	Nature of Malpractice/Misconduct	Scale of Punishment
1.	Either found in possession of incriminating material related to the subject of the examination concerned or found copying there from or copying from neighbour or interchanging of answer scripts.	Cancellation of the appearance in the particular paper in which malpractice has been committed and also the current semester papers.
2.	If the malpractice as above is repeated for the second time or more.	Cancellation of the examinations of all subjects registered for that session and debar for one subsequent examination to be appeared.
3.	Writing some other candidate's register number in the main answer paper if any	Cancellation of the examinations taken in all subjects during that sitting.
4.	Insertion of pre-written answer papers if any	All subjects of the semester papers are cancelled. Debarred for the next two examinations. Permitted to appear for the subsequent examination.
5.	For threatening the Invigilator or insubordinate behaviour based on the reports from the Chief Superintendent, Hall Superintendent.	Cancellation of the examinations of all subjects registered for that session and debar for two subsequent examinations.
6.	For assaulting the Invigilator	Cancellation of the examinations of all subjects registered for that session and debar for next four examinations.

7.	Cases of impersonation	Cancellation of the examinations of all the subjects registered for that session and debar for the subsequent four examinations. Moreover, relevant action should be initiated if an outsider is involved.
8.	Mass copying	<p><u>In the Single Hall:</u> Cancellation of the relevant examination taken by the students of that hall. Debar the concerned Hall Superintendent and others involved directly or indirectly from the examination work such as invigilation, question paper setting, valuation etc. for the next six examinations.</p> <p><u>In the Entire Centre:</u> Cancellation of the relevant examination taken by the students of the centre. Debar the Hall Superintendents and the Chief Superintendent and others involved directly or indirectly from the examination work such as invigilation, question paper setting, valuation etc, for the next examination and cancel the examination centre for two years (with intimation to DCE, DTE and DLS).</p>
