




Report of the National Webinar

Based on the nature and content of learning in the twenty-first century, the realm of education has been in a rapid period of transformation. Educators are faced with increasingly heightened pressures to establish and implement learning environments and experiences that are both appropriate and effective for all students (Bennett & Rolheiser, 2001). When planning instructional strategies and lessons, educators need not only to meet curriculum expectations, but they must also respond to the diverse factors that each student brings to the educational environment and experience (Bennett & Rolheiser, 2001). It is these diverse factors that play a crucial role in the manner in which instruction inside the classroom is planned and implemented. In the field of education, there exists a consensus that learners, regardless of age or grade, are defined by a vast amount of individual differences; as a result of these individual needs and differences, educators must adapt and implement instructional strategies accordingly (Alavinia & Farhady, 2012; Bennett & Rolheiser, 2001).

The recognition of knowledge and technology as drivers of growth undoubtedly left an indelible mark on curricula across the world. At the same time, growth should not be misconstrued as development, albeit a very critical part of it. The understanding of development has actually evolved from the predominantly economistic views of the 20th and even early 21st century. Development is a "more complex and holistic concept that includes economic growth, peace, political stability, social equity, sustainability, human capabilities and conditions, human rights and freedoms, culture, politics, ethics, morals, religion, knowledge, and technology among others" (Marope et al., 2015), underpinned by core values of equity, inclusion, equity, justice, and reconciliation. Beyond growth, countries expect their education systems to support holistic, inclusive, equitable, just, and sustainable development.


By the end of the first decade of the 21st century (2010), the combined shipment of desktop personal computers (PCs), laptops, and tablets had reached 377 million units worldwide, 435 million by 2016, and is forecast to reach 448 million by 2021. By 2013, 2,038.27 million mobile phones (of all types) were shipped worldwide, and the number is forecast to reach 2,419.34 by 2020 (Statista, 2020). Industry 4.0 is exponentially accelerating the permeation of technology in all aspects of life like never before.



In a blended learning classroom, as opposed to a traditional classroom, instructors transition from teacher to facilitator and back.

However, while technology emerged as a savior, it is not possible to achieve thorough learning only by listening or watching content. Instead of championing technologies in which pedagogy is irrelevant, schools must invest in helping students become lifelong learners, enrich their learning processes, and focus on critical self-reflection, problemsolving skills, imagination, ideas, and projects involving social problems. A significant attempt to redefine the concepts that we have traditionally used must be made.



The second day Technical session (24.02.2022) was handled by Dr. A.Jahitha Begum, Proessor & Head, Department of Education, Gandhigram Rural Institute, Gandhigram, Dindigul on the topic of "Paradign Shift in Learning in 21st Century". In this session she explains about Twenty-first-century learning embodies an approach to teaching that marries content to skill. Without skills, students are left to memorize facts, recall details for worksheets, and relegate their educational experience to passivity. 21st century pedagogy aims to develop the skills and knowledge students need to succeed in work, life and citizenship. 21st century skills can be applied in all subject areas, and in all educational, career, and civic settings throughout a student's life.



About 245 participants across country were participated and benefitted through this online seminar. Some participants were given their feedback about the webinar. The second day session winded up with national anthem. **Dr. R. Annadurai, Director of the Centre, Dr.B.Kannan & Dr. M. Rajeshkumar, Assistant professors** of the centre has arranged the programme.
