OBSERVATIONS

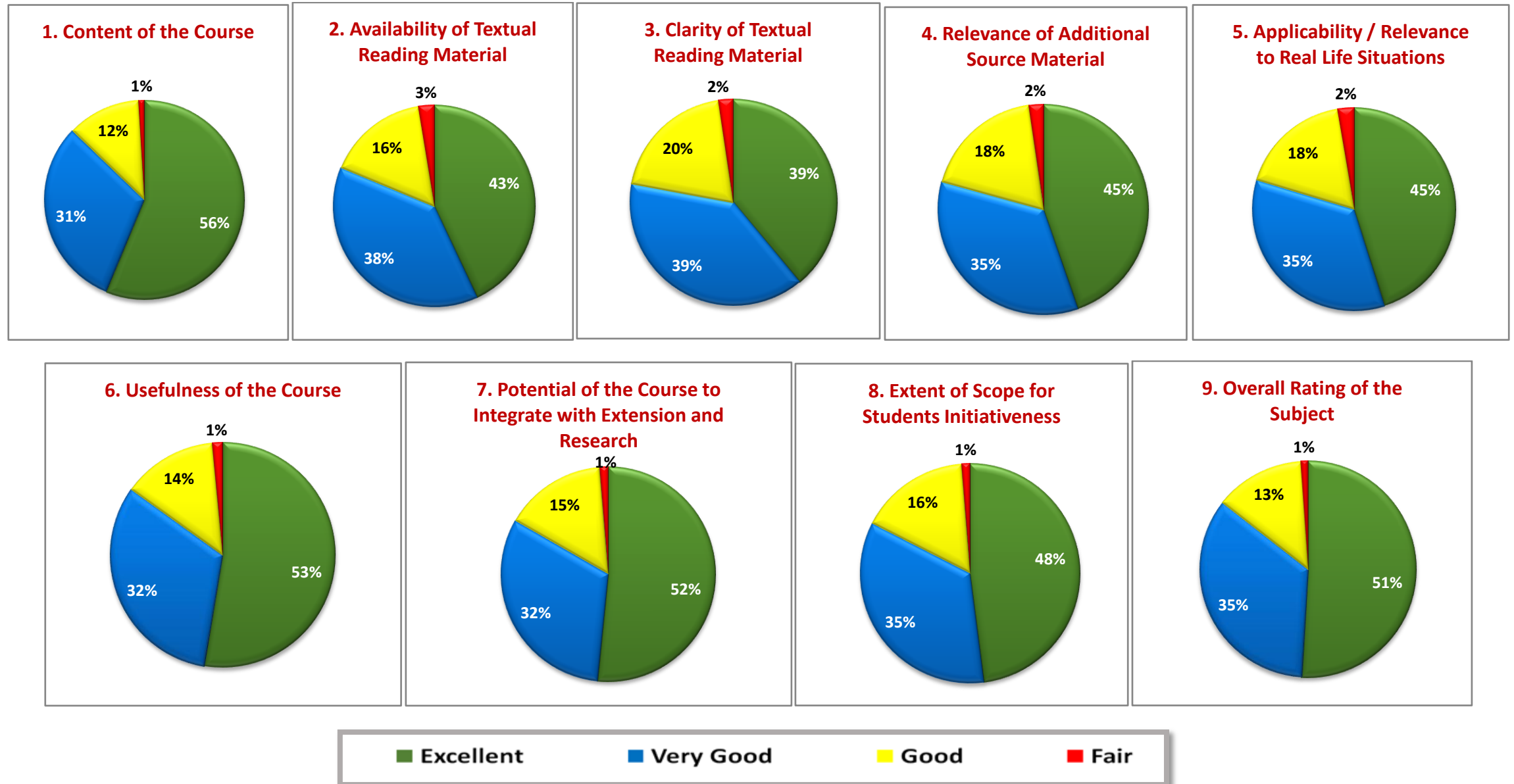
Students play an important role in curriculum revision

- About 45% to 50% of the students appreciated the content of the course, availability of reading material, additional source material, applicability and usefulness, potential of the course to integrate with extension and research and the scope of student's initiativeness.
- They are happy (45% to 50%) with the teacher guidance and counselling, Staff-student relationship recreation and health care facilities.
- Students are highly satisfied (70% - 80%) by the teaching methods, Coverage of Syllabus, conduct of CFA tests and Examination System.
- The feedback on the academic procedure shows that Students are unsatisfied over Laboratory (6%), Internet (18%), Hostel facilities (24%) and Exam system (6%).
- Regarding the library faculties, the 6% of the Students are unsatisfied with Department and with General Library (8%). Students are unsatisfied of the Health care facilities available at University Health Care Centre (13%).

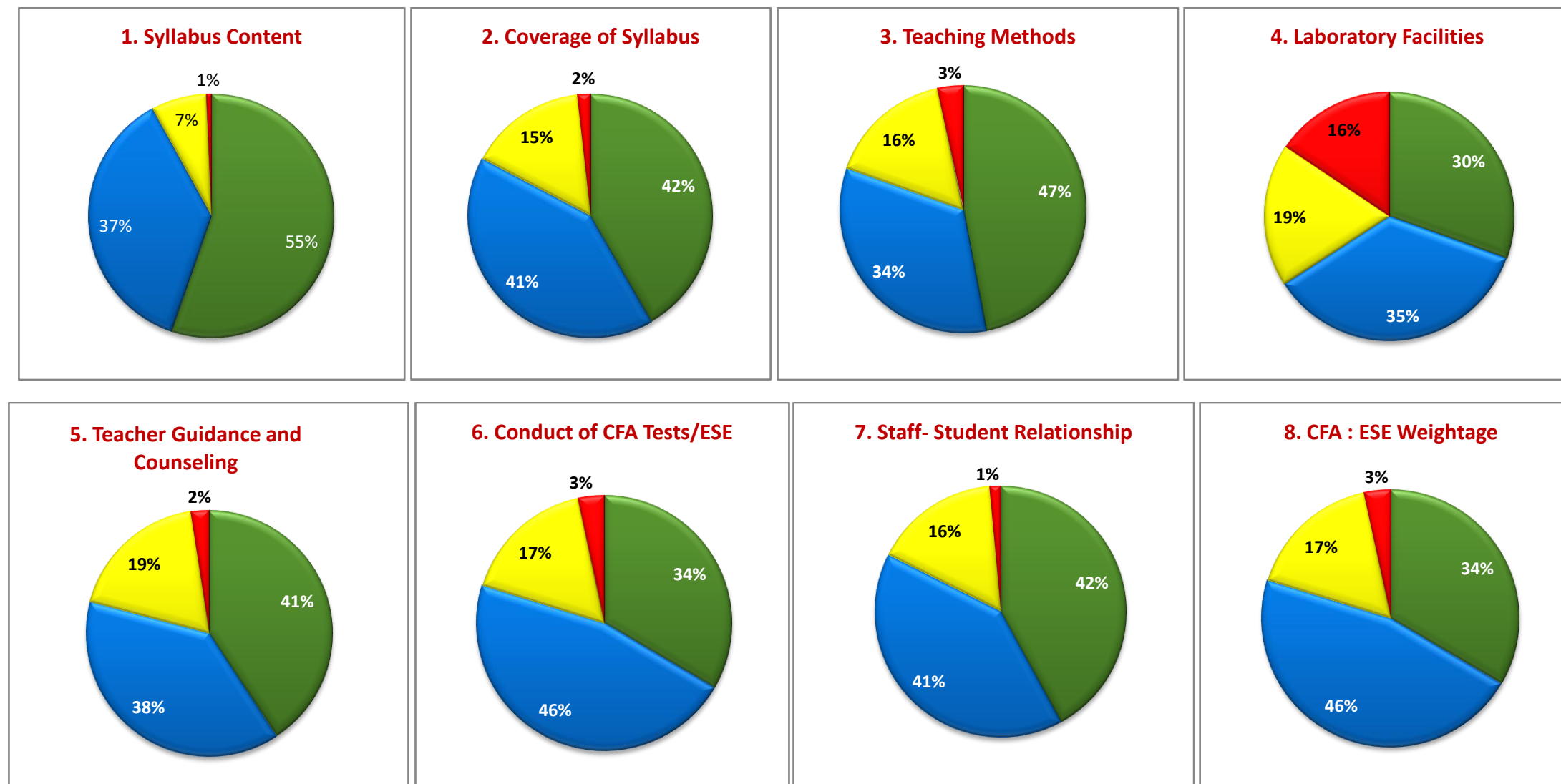

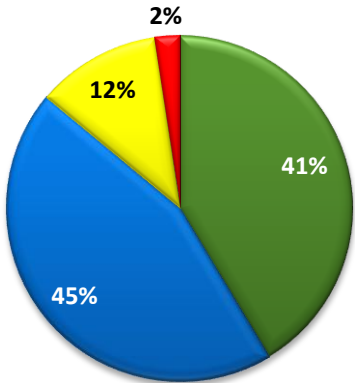
OVERALL RATING OF PROGRAMME (2013-2015)



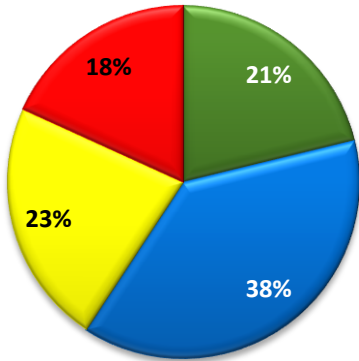
