Madurai Kamaraj University started a unique Evening College on the 15th December 1979 in its old campus situated opposite to Pandiyan Hotel and Circuit House on Alagarkoil Road, Madurai-2. The concept of Evening College was evolved particularly for the benefit of employed / self-employed aspirants. From its inception, the college catered to the educational needs of lakhs and lakhs of aspirants who were not able to undergo higher studies through regular made of education in and around Madurai. By an order of UGC, New Delhi No.F.8-84/91(CPP-I) dated: 3rd June 1994, the Evening College was elevated to Madurai Kamaraj University College as a Constituent Institution of Madurai Kamaraj university from the academic year 1994-95. Even then the Evening College co-existed for its determined aim of providing higher education to the working people who could not pursue their studies in regular stream. As such, the yeomen services of the evening college continued up to 2012, when it was merged with Madurai Kamaraj University College, Madurai -2. The sudden closure of Evening College had shut down the opportunity of many aspirants' desire to study UG and PG courses.

In order to help the employed persons and in view of the increased demand for higher degree courses, the Madurai Kamaraj University Evening College was re-established on the 15th December 2017. The college offers M.Phil. Courses in 21 subjects from the academic year 2017-2018. At present, PG Courses in M.A. English, M.Sc. Mathematics and M.B.A. are offered. More UG and PG courses will be offered from the academic year 2020-2021. The college will certainly work towards the quality of education aiming at achieving excellence, equity and employability for the student community.

1. Preamble

Madurai Kamaraj University Evening College started to function from December 15, 1969, to cater to the needs of the employed persons desirous of pursuing their studies after office hours and for those ambitious of doing their higher studies.

2. Course and Duration

A. The course consists of two semesters and each semester has 90 working days.

B. For the first semester, theory paper examinations shall be held after the end of the semester.

For the second semester, Dissertation shall be submitted after the end of the semester.

C. University conducts semester examinations in the months of November / April every year.

Duration : Two semesters
One semester : 90 working days

3. Eligibility for Admission

A. The candidate should have completed 10+2+3+2 years pattern of study.

B. The candidate should have obtained the eligibility certificate to join the M.Phil. Course in the respective discipline to join the M.Phil. Course in the respective discipline after undergoing the common entrance test conducted by the Madurai Kamaraj University.

C. Candidates who have passed **UGC NET/TNSET/CSIR NET** are **also eligible to apply.**

4. Admission Procedure

On the basis of marks of M.Phil qualification test the candidates will be ranked and selected based on the reservation policy of Government of Tamilnadu. Those who do not have qualifying certificate need to appear for the entrance test and interview for admission conducted by the university.

On receipt of admission intimation, Candidates willing to join the program should submit prescribed original certificates, for verification at the time of admission and remit the fees as prescribed by the university within the stipulated date. Selected candidates who do not report for joining or do not pay the fee within the stipulated date will forfeit the seat offered.

The university reserves the right to add any new M.Phil program or withdraw any program advertised.
