1. GENERAL INFORMATION :

M.K.U. Evening College was started in 1994 and it has completed 26 years of existence. The Evening College was founded with a view to catering to the needs of the employed, the socially and economically marginalised sections of both the urban and the rural people who want to pursue higher study. The academic year commences in July and winds up in April. The college admits both men and women students in all branches. There is no hostel accommodation for students. The classes start at 5.00 p.m. and close at 8.00 p.m.

The Post-Graduate courses offered in M.K.U. Evening College, Dindigul are M.A. Tamil, M.A. English, MBA., M.A. History, M.Sc. Maths, M.Com. and M.Sc. Computer Science. The medium of instruction is English. The courses are on the semester pattern.

2. Application Form

The cost of application form is Rs.300/- One application should be used for one course. The application should be legibly filled in by the applicant's own handwriting. Applications are issued free of cost for the applicants belonging to SC and ST communities on producing valid community certificate. The University reserves the rights to suspend admission to any course. Applications for all PG Courses must be submitted to the college office exactly after 15 days after the publication of the UG results by Madurai Kamaraj University.

3. Attendance :

Students have to earn a minimum of 75% attendance to sit for the examinations. Students have to write two Internal Tests in a semester. Without Internal Marks students automatically disqualify themselves from writing the university examinations. Students have to pay all the fees on time without fail. If they fail to pay the fees, they will not be allowed to write the examinations.

4. Identity Card

Each student will be issued an identity card after the admission is over. This card should be kept by the students till the completion of the course. If the original card is lost, a duplicate I.D. card will be issued on payment of Rs.100/- students have to bring the ID Card when come to college and to the examination hall.

5. Enclosure
