## **Common Entrance Test for admission to M.Phil./Ph.D. 2020-2021**

The Common Entrance Test (CET) is scheduled on 19.12.2020, Saturday, from 10.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon with duration of 2 hours. The entrance test consists of 100 questions in multiple choice form - 50 in general and 50 in their subject concerned. ### **The following are the general instructions to the candidates registered for the CET:**

- i. The Madurai Kamaraj University is conducting the M.Phil./Ph.D. Entrance Test through online mode due to Covid-19 Pandemic situation.
- ii. Candidates can take up the online entrance test from their own location and they are advised to ensure uninterrupted power supply and stable internet connectivity in their location during the exam.
- iii. Candidates can take up the exam with their Desktop / Laptop with web camera & Mic and Android Mobile Phones / Tablet using broadband connection / Mobile data (3G/4G) service.
- iv. In case of any technical/connectivity issue/power interruption, the candidate will be permitted to re-login for a maximum of 3 times. Beyond this, the application will not allow the candidates to continue the exam.
- v. Two Mock Tests will be conducted for the candidates to get familiarity with the on-line exam. Duration of Mock Test: 30 Minutes, 25 MCQ. Entrance Test for M.Phil./Ph.D. - Mock Test will be on 17 & 18 Dec 2020. Login link and other information will be sent to the candidates E-mail.
- vi. Candidates are advised to check their e-mail regularly for updates regarding Mock test, Login credentials and any other information.
- vii. Candidates should not indulge in malpractices to get external assistance in any form to answer the questions which will lead to disqualification of candidature.
- viii. Candidates will be monitored by the proctors online by capturing their images and audio.
- ix. If any candidate indulges in any kind of malpractices, then the proctor will expel the candidates from taking the exam.
