

## About **MKU**

Madurai Kamaraj University (MKU), a state University founded in 1965, has been designated as University with Potential for Excellence in 'Teaching, Research, and Outreach' and is currently accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with an A++ grade. The major objectives of the centres are to promote collaborative research, by providing access to advanced research facilities and to impart training to young researchers working in the frontier areas of their respective subjects. SBS was recognized as a "Networking Resource Centre in Biological Sciences (NRCBS)" in the year 2008.

UGC-NRCBS, MKU, with its state-of-the-art infrastructure, is functioning as a resource centre for training and research collaborations. The activities of the UGC- NRCBS include: i) organizing summer and winter schools, ii) guidance for Ph.D. students from other Institutes on experimental trouble shooting and research methodology, iii) support for Ph.D students who are in need of equipment / laboratory facilities and iv) strengthening the collaborative research initiatives in Biological Sciences among Universities and Research Institutes, v) Train the post graduate students of other Institutes on experimental trouble shooting and research methodology. The theme of the proposed Summer School on "Research methodology" is offered by UGC NRCBS (Phase II), School of Biological Sciences, Madurai Kamaraj University, Madurai - 625 021.

## About the Programme

Aimed to train young researchers on the basic concepts of research methodology which includes research design, sampling methods, data collection and analysis, working principles and applications of instruments and manuscript writing.

# Nature of the Course:

The participants can apply them in their research programmes. The programme will be methodologies oriented and emphasises on demonstration of instruments, hands on training in biostatistics with SPSS statistical software and class room lectures. The participants will carry out the guided exercises individually or as a group. In addition, lectures from the experts/scientists will be organized on current trends in the selected area.

# Eligibility

Research Scholars, Post-docs, Young Faculty Members and Scientists (from various disciplines of Life Sciences) of Indian Universities/Colleges/Research Institutes to apply for this Summer school.

### **Application and Selection Procedure**

The shortlisted candidates will be notified through email in the third week of February 2022. Candidates will be chosen based on research interests.
