RESULTS AND DISCUSSIONS

Hostel Adjustment among undergraduate students in Madurai.

The empirical average of Hostel Adjustment among undergraduate students in Madurai is found to be 136, while the theoretical average is 100 only. This shows that Hostel Adjustment among undergraduate students in Madurai is found well above the average level.

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
